## COURSE TOUR



Named after the woodland area bordering the left side of the fairway, which is often inhabited by the local crow population. At 549 yards this is a strong par 5. Keeping to the right side of the fairway off the tee offers a more open view for the second shot.



Although this par 3 has a stroke index of 18, the shelter provided by the trees on the tee leads many a player to misjudge club and distance, leaving them in the pond at the front of the green.
